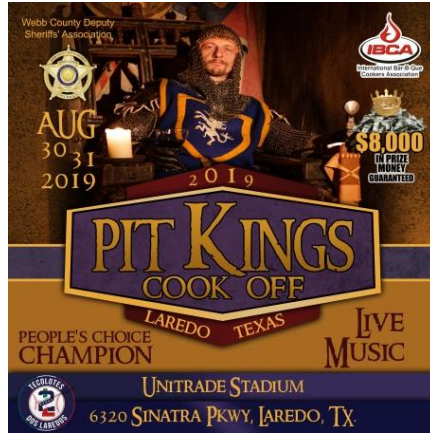

PIT KINGS Cook-Off Rules & Guidelines

IBCA rules apply for anything not specifically covered here. Please refer to www.ibcabbq.org

1. **Entry Fee:** \$200.00 per team. Teams shall consist of one (1) Head Cook and up to four (4) team members.
2. **Meeting:** There will be a Head Cook's meeting at 7:30 am on Saturday August 31st in the Judging area.
3. **FIRE Extinguisher:** Every team must have a Fire Extinguisher. The City of Laredo Health Department will be on site inspecting.
4. **Cooked On Site:** All meat entries must be prepared and cooked on site.
5. **Entries per PIT:** IBCA recognizes only one entry per head cook on a given pit. It will be the responsibility of the Promoter to monitor entries. Notwithstanding, multiple entries in the same category by the same cook or from the same pit, or multiple entries from the same piece of meat shall not be allowed.
6. **BBQ Pits:** Any commercial or homemade, trailered or untrailered, pit or smoker normally used for competitive barbeque. A BBQ Pit may include gas or electricity for starting the combustion of wood or wood products but NOT to complete cooking. Pit should be of a permanent design that contains separate individual cooking chambers and heat sources. (no sharing of heat sources) NO Open Fire or Ground Fires allowed. Teams must have a fire extinguisher readily available.
7. **Site Space:** A 36' X 36' space will be provided for each entry. The cook-off area has asphalt bottom and No Water or Electricity is provided. Spaces will be selected during registration.
8. **Alcohol: BYOB** No alcohol will be sold at the event.
9. **Sanitation:** Cooks are to prepare and cook in as sanitary manner as is possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by the Promoter. Infractions identified by the judging committee shall be immediately corrected or the cook will be subject to disqualification.
10. **Vehicle Traffic:** All traffic lanes in the contest area must be open at all times. Vehicles will be allowed in cook-off area for drop off and pick up only on Friday from 12pm – 10pm and again on Saturday from 5am -7am. Vehicle traffic access will be monitored and one vehicle will be allowed in the campsite as long as it is inside the 36' X 36' site space.
11. **Prohibited:** No pets (except for service animals). No golf carts or ATV's will be allowed on the event grounds.
12. **Turn-in Times:** All times are subject to change. Estimated times are as followed

10:00 AM	Ribeye Steak
12:00 PM	Chicken
1:30 PM	Pork Spare Ribs
3:00 PM	Beef Brisket

13. **Head Cook responsibility:** The Head Cook of each team is responsible for the conduct of his/her team members and guests. The Webb County Deputy Sheriffs' Association and the PIT Kings Cook-Off Committee and volunteers are not responsible for loss of items, damage of property, or any injuries sustained to any person attending the event.
14. **Prizes:** Awards presentation will be at 5:00 PM on Saturday August 31st 2019. The Grand Champion will receive \$1,000 , and an engraved King's sword. The Reserve Grand Champion will receive \$550.00 and a trophy. The People's Choice winner will be receive a Championship Belt.
